

Hymnic Notes: Issac Watts wrote "From All That Dwell Below the Skies" for his 1719 publication *The Psalms of David, Imitated*. It was one of three paraphrases he wrote based on Psalm 117, and it was first published in two verses. In 1780 John Wesley published a version with an added two verses. These verses are included in the *United Methodist Hymnal*, *Trinity Hymnal*, and *Presbyterian Hymnal*. The hymn tune Duke Street is often used with this text, along with another famous Watts text "Jesus Shall Reign Where'er the Sun."
