

Today's Music: Mozart wrote the Latin anthem, *Veni Sancte Spiritus*, at the age of 12. It was likely a compositional exercise in preparation for the *Missa Brevis in G major*. The text was a sequence hymn of the Catholic Church, meaning that it would be sung on a feast day after the reading of the Gospel. However, Mozart titled the work "offertory," so it is unclear when it would have been used and what his intentions were. The piece was originally scored for orchestra, soloists and chorus. The piece shows that even at twelve years old, Mozart already had a firm grasp on melody and harmony. It also displays a creative spirit that would be cherished for generations.
