

It first appeared in six stanzas in the poet's collection, *Visions of Death, and Other Poems*, 1833. The hymn first appeared in the Dutch Reformed Church's *Sabboth School and Social Hymns*, 1843. The hymn first appeared in Methodist hymnals in 1878. In our current hymnal, revisions were made to the text for inclusivity. (Carlton Young)
